

## Integrity Declaration on Respecting Human Rights and Preventing Forced Labour

BISOL Group hereby makes, on its behalf as a company as well as its affiliates, the following declaration related to human rights violations and forced labour exploitations.

It is the explicit and utmost responsibility of BISOL Group to be aware and prevent any possible exploitations of the human rights, in our own production of Solar PV Modules as well as throughout the whole supply chain that BISOL Group is using for its products.

At BISOL Group we engage to operate in a manner that respects human rights, including with respect to forced labour, as well as to operate transparently and in a manner that seeks to meet or exceed international standards such as the OECD Guidelines for Multinational Enterprises and the UN Guiding Principles for Business and Human Rights.

Uyghur human rights in the region of Xinjiang, the People's Republic of China, have long been debated. At BISOL Group, we most seriously condemn any violations of human rights and exploitation of forced labour anywhere in the world. To help prevent possible violations, we are committed to thoroughly checking and evaluating our suppliers, including their sourcing routes.

We hereby explicitly declare to have not sourced, directly or indirectly, any products or services from suppliers implicated in human rights or forced labour violations related to the alleged repression of Uyghurs and other ethnic minorities in the Xinjiang Uyghur Autonomous Region (XUAR).
